


# Safety Advice

### Intended Use

The transmitter may only be used to operate Easywave radio controls.

The manufacturer shall not be liable for any damage caused by improper or non-intended use!

#### Function

The RT30 Mini Transmitters are radio transmitters with 3- or 4-button operation. The transmitters are A/B/C/D-coded, so that four different radiograms can be transmitted and therefore four different functions can be controlled.

The transmitters use a battery control function. If the battery is weak, the LED flashes during sending.

### Start-Up

Transfer the transmitter codes to the radio receivers of the devices to be operated. For this read the operating instructions supplied with the radio receivers.

### **Using the Transmitter**


Press and hold the transmitter button until the LED lights up.



In case the LED flashes while pressing the pushbutton as well as approx. 3 seconds after releasing it, please change the battery.

## Replacing the Battery


- Insert a small coin into the slot on the bottom side of the transmitter. Turn the coin diagonally and carefully press the two halves of the housing apart.
- Replace the battery. Use only batteries of type CR2032. Make sure the polarity is correct!



### **Troubleshooting**

- The LED glows only faintly while being active: Change the battery.
- The LED does not light up at all: Check the polarity of the battery.
- Move closer to the radio receiver or transfer the transmitter code(s) to the radio receiver(s) again.
